Weather Graph

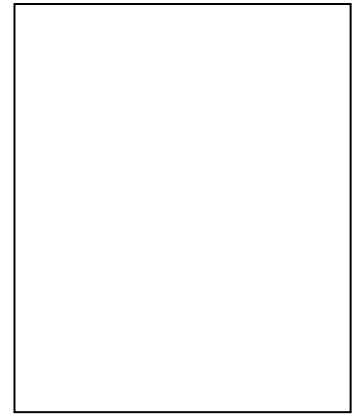

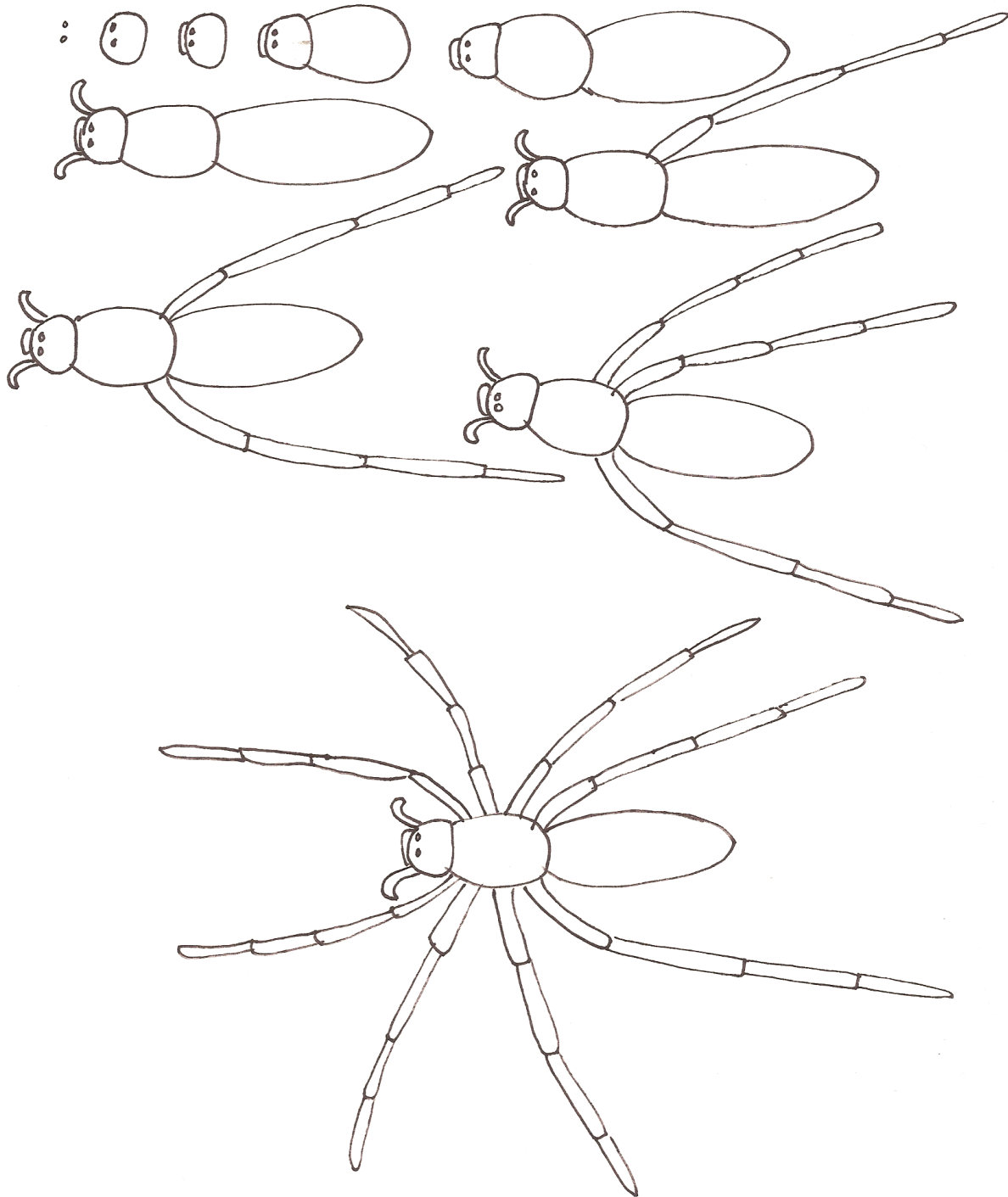

Steps for Drawing a Spider
