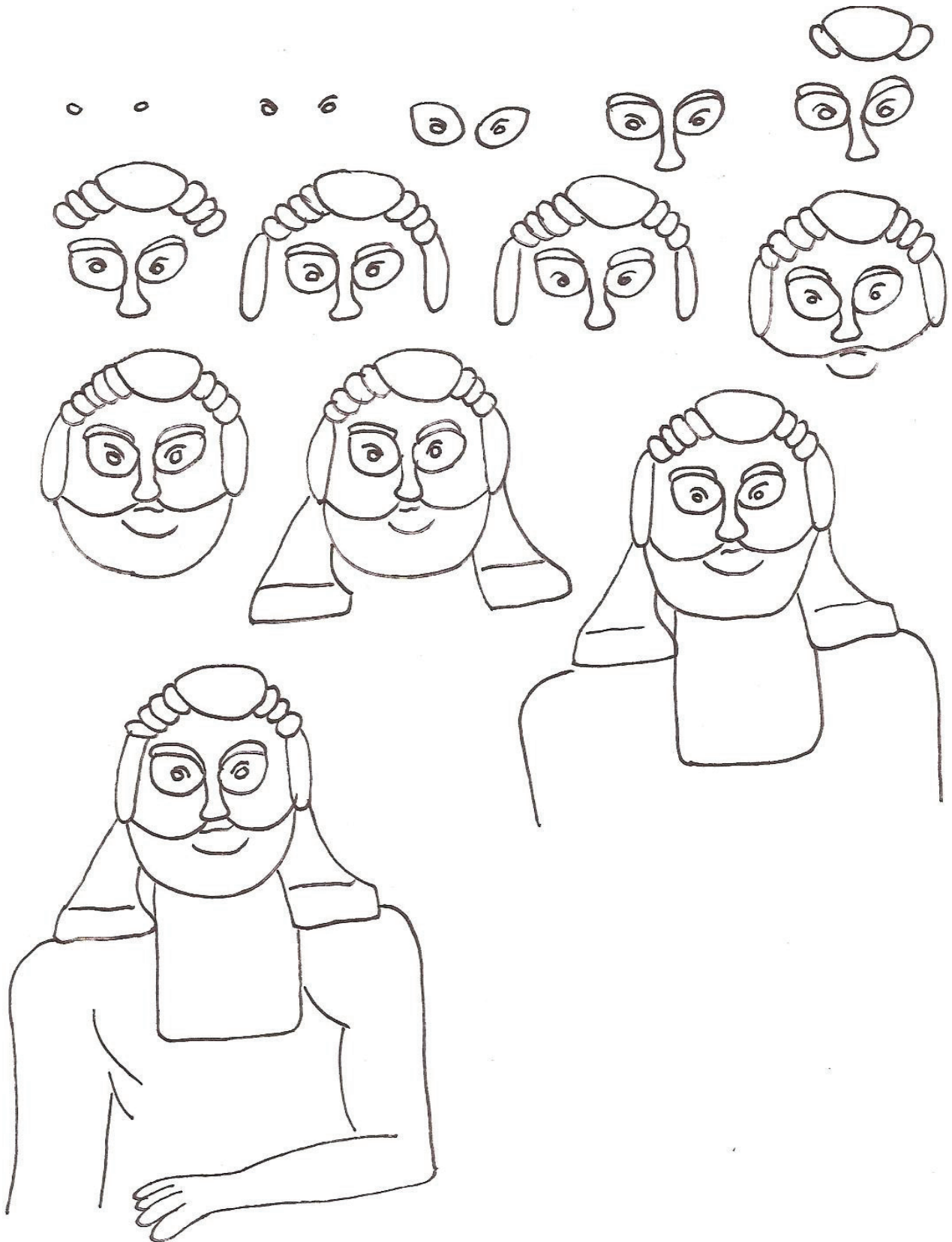
Overlapping Exercise

Here are some examples of what you can do with the overlapping exercises. Feel free to make up your own and be creative.



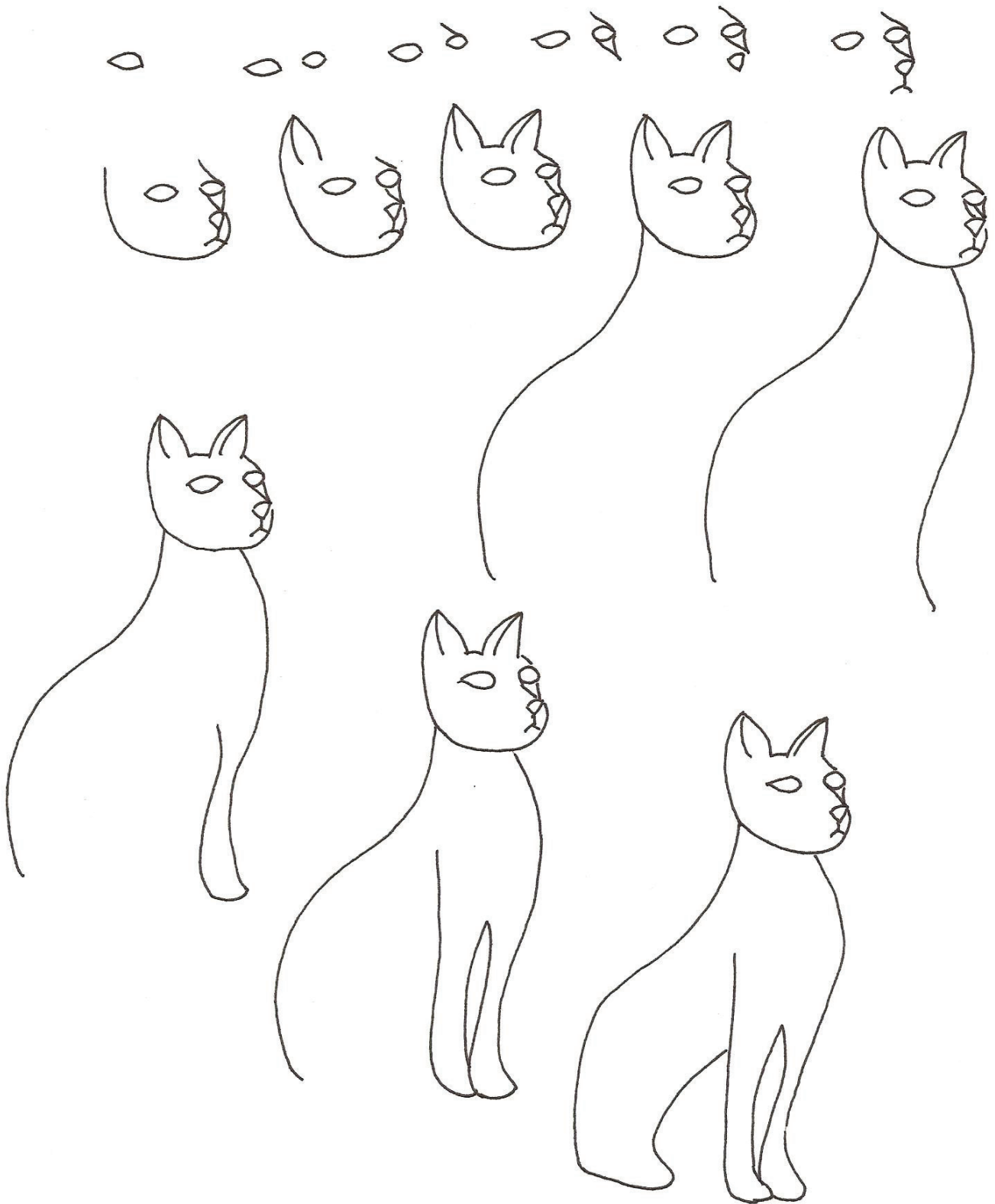
Gilgamesh Drawing

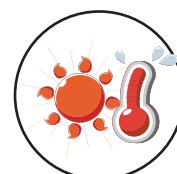

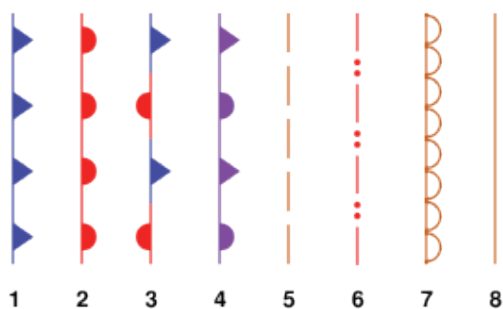
