## Preface to the Teacher

If you have used my *Ancient Copybook*, you will have noticed that this copybook is much thicker than its predecessor. This time period of history has so many wonderful sources for copywork, from early epic poems, such as Beowulf, to the profound thoughts of theologians like Martin Luther, that I had a hard time being selective. I thought that I would give you, the parent and teacher of your child, that prerogative. This means that they may be sections you choose not to use, depending on the age and writing level of your child.

Along with the selections in this book, I would encourage you to choose passages from your read-aloud literature, as well as hymns and poems, and Scripture, to round out your child's copywork curriculum. A simple schedule could be:

Monday: copy a hymn or new Scripture memory verse for the week

Tuesday – Thursday: use the *Middle Ages Copybook*

Friday: Choose a passage from your read-aloud literature OR take a previously copied selection and give it as a dictation exercise to your child.

I hope you will enjoy using this book. May your children grow as did our Lord Jesus: “in wisdom, in stature, and in favor with God and man” (Luke 2:52).
