









Have your child verbally retell the paragraph from the key word outline in these first couple of lessons, until he gets the hang of it.</p> <p>Grammar: These two icons   will alert you to a new grammar jingle or rule. Use the "Grammar jingle" and "Grammar Rules" sheets provided in your packet to record the jingles and rules if this encourages learning.</p> <p>PE: Each day at about 10:00 am do Roll-ups, Pull-ups, Kangaroo jumps and Flies.
